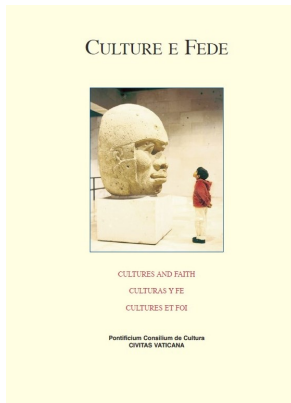




## PRE-COLUMBIAN CULTURES
